Prizes: To be awarded in the form of "Trader Bucks."

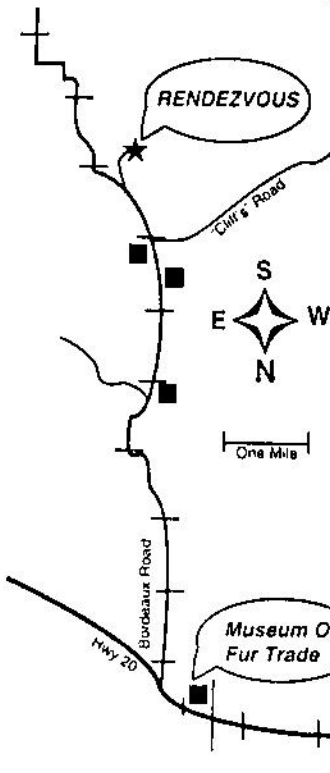
